



Brother Sam traveled to visit with the saints of Narrow Way Ministries, Concord, NC on June 1-3. This was his first visit to the new building that the church and bible school had recently occupied. One of the goals of the visit was to dedicate this new building to the glory of God and the other goal was to minister to the precious people here, as directed by the Holy Spirit.

Friday June 1, Brother Sam ministered from Malachi 4:5-6 regarding the

The following meeting on Saturday, June 2, the message shared with the congregation came from Revelation 5:1-5, regarding the seven seals on the scroll. Brother Sam pointed out that

Papa Sam,

The Narrow Way family in Cochabamba wants to honor your life today and tell you that we are very grateful to Jesus because one day, being a young man, you said "yes" to His love and salvation, just like millions of others in the world have done. But you went farther than where the majority go. You decided in your heart to surrender your own life, out of love for Him and His bride.

That day, without us knowing, our future began to change. The mercy of God towards Cochabamba was so great that He chose to use you to be the instrument through which He would reveal Himself to this house of disciples with an anointing of love so sweet, a weight of glory so evident
