


"Have not I written to thee excellent things..." Proverbs 22:20

Dear Friends & Family,

In preparing for this month's teaching, the Lord brought me to a passage in Zechariah that I find very glorious! Let us begin by reading in Zechariah as he is prophesying about the last days:

"The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah. ⁸In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them." (Zech. 12:6–12)

What a glorious promise! "In that day" speaking of the last days, the Lord will have a people that were once "feeble" but will be "as David" who in turn are going to be "as God." In other words, in the last days, God is going to have a group of over comers called the manifested sons of God.

First of all, what does David represent? David was not only a weak and frail man full of all kinds of iniquities, but at the same time he was a mighty overcomer. He is somebody in the Old Testament that we look to over and over again that

prevailed in many, many situations. He defeated Goliath. He survived and overcame Saul. He led Israel as king in battle and defeated all their enemies round about to bring peace and rest to his generation. He was responsible for laying the groundwork for Solomon's temple and his son's prosperous reign. So to be as David means to be an overcomer. In the last days, God is going to have a company of overcomers ushering in the last great move of God.

But it begins with the Lord saving "the tents of Judah first." Judah in the Hebrew means "praise." They are a type of worshippers and those who spiritually dwell in Zion. They are those in the body of Christ that have allowed Jesus to be enthroned in everything they do. Every praiser, every person that lives in Zion is going to be "as God" and "as the angel of the Lord before them." So in the last days, God is going to raise up a people, who like David have things in their life that are uncomely and areas of weakness, but because of their devoted love for the Lord. they overcome and become mightily used of the Lord. Moreover, to the church and to the world, they will be "as God."

Consider Moses in Exodus. In chapter 4, Moses is arguing with the Lord about not wanting to go to speak on the Lord's behalf to Pharaoh to let God's people go. So the



Lord tells Moses in verse 14 to go and get Aaron, "Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well." Moses was trying to use the excuse that he couldn't speak well. Moreover, the Lord continues and explains how this will all work:

"15 And thou shalt speak unto him, and put words in his mouth: and I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do. 16 And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be, even he shall be to thee instead of a mouth, and thou shalt be to him instead of God. 17 And thou shalt take this rod in thine hand, wherewith thou shalt do signs." (Exodus 4:15–17)

In other words, Moses was going to be to Aaron "as God." Aaron then would be to the people as a spokesperson.

Speaking of the last days, Micah 4:5 says, "For all people will walk every one in the name of his god, and we will walk in the name of the Lord our God for ever and ever." Names in Scripture represents somebody's character. In other words, in the last days every single person is choosing what character or god they will be walking in or representing. For the overcomers, they

will be walking in the reputation and character of Jesus. The sons of God are nothing more than regular people manifesting Jesus wherever they go. God's glory is going to be revealed to the world and to the church through a group of overcomers. These people are going to be just like Jesus. Everything in these last days is moving quickly towards fullness.

Consider with me now a passage in II Thessalonians:

"3Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God." (II Thessalonians 2:3–4)

First of all, this passage is speaking of the antichrist. I personally believe the antichrist is not one person but is a spirit that tries to live and move through every single person. John said in I John 2:18, "Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists, whereby we know that it is the last time." In Revelation 3:17-18, it defines the number of his name, 666. Six in Scripture is the number for man and satan. In the last days, everything is coming to fullness. Therefore 666, is simply the fullness of satan and the fullness of man coming together. Men already think they are god in this world. In these last days, this antichrist spirit is going to rise up and cause those who are open to it to walk in the name of their god. And that god will be themselves. Now they will be deceived because satan will be behind all of it. But nonetheless, they will show themselves as God.

Secondly, they will be "sitting in the temple of God." Who is the temple of God? Well, II Corinthians 6:16 says we are the temple of the living God. Therefore, whoever is sitting is sitting in us. I believe this speaks of allowing our unredeemed nature to take the preeminence and rule our lives instead of the Spirit of God. Therefore "sitting in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God" is simply people saying to God that they can do this without Him. Antichrist means you say you don't need Jesus for anything in your life. It is believing the lie that we can do it on our own. Therefore, the fullness of 666 is mankind really at their worst when they think in their mind that they are at their best or height of success and control.

But contrariwise, God is going to have a people who have overcome, have died to themselves, and therefore will have the privilege of manifesting Jesus wherever they go. While others will be full of satan and antichrist, God will have a people that will be full of the Spirit of God revealing Jesus to the world.

Therefore, in the last days, God will have a people that will properly represent Jesus to the church and then to the world. Doesn't that put some pressure on us then to truly walk in holiness and all the things God's Word says we should be walking in? When we say to people that there will be a people that will be "as God," it is ascribing to them a whole lot of authority and expectation because they will be Jesus to everyone with whom they come in contact. Our calling is to act like Jesus, talk like Jesus, walk like Jesus, and think like Jesus. What an honor and calling!

In so much of history, Jesus'

name has been so misused and misrepresented. The church has failed in so many ways to show a true example of who Jesus really is. But God is going to fix that in the last days. He is going to repair and save the tents of Judah first. Zion is going to be filled with Jesus and His glory. They in turn will arise and shine that glory to the church and then to the world. And the last great revival will take place. I believe millions of people will get saved and come into the Kingdom of God. Many people in the church that have backslidden will come back to the Lord and say as Jeremiah 50:5 says, "They shall ask the way to Zion..." The overcomers will point the way and lead them back to the place where Jesus is first in their life. Isaiah 2:3 says "And many people shall go and say, come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem."

By the grace of God, you and I have the opportunity and calling to be "as God" to everyone around us. True humility is receiving and believing all that God has said and called us to and then dving to self to walk in it. Romans 8:29 says we are "to be conformed to the image of his Son." Every single part of Jesus is going to be part of the sons of God: His love, His mercy, His kindness, His attitude against sin, His purity, etc. As we together press towards this mark in all of our lives, my prayer for me and for you is when people look at us, they don't see us anymore but they see Jesus. They will see the Jesus in us and we will be "as God" to them manifesting His glory! Jesus is Precious!

Here are the reports from the three cities from the pastor in each place. Brother Sam said it was one of his best trips to Bolivia ever. The hunger & move of God there was a beautiful thing to see & behold:



La Paz, Bolivia

Papa's visit to Bolivia was a tremendous time, words cannot even begin to describe. What a wonderful blessing is to have a true and genuine relationship with your spiritual father, which brings real and total covering in the ministry! Not only the cities of Santa Cruz and Cochabamba were deeply impacted, but also La Paz, the headquarters of South America.

The way the Holy Spirit used Brother Sam during this trip in particular was amazing. The prophetic accuracy was so sharp in every single word the Lord gave him; the teachings and preaching throughout the trip were dead on spot. It was also wonderful to see him in a very healthy and alert shape! We can truly see how the blessing of the Lord was upon his life in the natural and the spiritual realms after he has obeyed the Lord on moving on towards the next

phase of the ministry He has given him and proceed to move in the apostolic ministry now. You can truly see an increase of the gifts over his life, as well as a body not as drained as in the past with all the burden from being a pastor (after 40+ years!).

As the Lord continues to open up the doors for Narrow Way Ministries International, Brother Sam was able to share with the Bible School students of a sister church here in La Paz, which we've been working with for over a year now. Despite some warfare, usual to these kind of open meetings, we received tremendous words of direction and encouragement as a ministry. Many people received the baptism in the Holy Spirit (over 50 throughout the trip in Bolivia) and others were ministered to on a personal ministry basis. The prophetic mantle was upon Brother Sam in every meeting and it was undeniable that the Holy Spirit was speaking through him, bringing words of edification, exhortation and comfort.

It was also so comforting and confirming to have Papa speak before the congregation over our lives (Pablo and Pamela) and remind them of the vision of Narrow Way Ministries. There is truly nothing more comforting than to have a true father in the Lord to come in and put things in order in the house with

authority and love. How privileged we are!

Now, as we prepare here in La Paz to move to a new building by the end of this year, we are expectant and thrilled to have Papa Sam back in Bolivia to dedicate the first-ever building of Narrow Way Ministries in the nations. What a glorious time that will be!!! So looking forward to have the people from Santa Cruz, Cochabamba, Jacksonville and the nations over for such an awesome time. Cochabamba, Bolivia


Narrow Way Ministries Cochabamba had a glorious time from April 16th
