## Until I Deborah Arose A Mother In Israel

In this month's teaching, I want us to turn to the book of Judges and look at women in the last days through the story of Deborah and Jael. It is important we see women's pivotal role the body of Christ. What truly is their calling and destiny? I couldn't help but hear the Spirit of the Lord saying to me this morning, "lift up your eyes." So much of the time we are looking at things around us and our present circumstances. So much of what we see can be overwhelming. The Bible is full of exhortations to lift up our heads and lift up our eyes! Why? Because the Lord wants us to see into the heavenly realm, especially in these last days. Proverbs 1:17 says, *"Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird."* As we fly in heavenly places over this earth, we are able to see the enemy's tactics and see what he is doing. I believe now, more than ever, Jesus wants us to begin to lift up our eyes to the coming move of God, especially when it comes to women.

I have been waiting for so long in my own heart and life for that precious last day move of God. I believe it is coming. But I believe God had to use these many years to prove, test, and set things in order. What preparation the Lord is doing to finally reveal Himself through a people in this earth! God is going to manifest the Lord Jesus through a people to the earth. The earth is going to see the real character of God, the real face of Jesus, in this people. And for that to happen, quite a bit of dealings must have taken place. I know during these past few years, the Lord has been working overtime it seems in so many of our lives. But if there is any flesh re-

maining in any one of us, God wants to and needs to burn it out. In this teaching, I want to look particularly at what the Bible says about the role in women bringing this last great move of God. Women in the last days are going to have a great and powerful destiny in God. Perhaps the thing we all have been waiting for is them to simply arise and take their place.

First of all let me state, that everybody, men and women, need to be submitted to God-given authority. There will always be those with controlling personalities, submitted to nobody, that want to take over everything. I am not talking to these people. But I do want to particularly speak to those precious women that are in proper relationship that carry the true authority and calling of God. They need to come forth more than ever and many weak-minded, insecure men have kept them back long enough. In the Spirit and in Christ Jesus, Paul declares *"there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus"* (Galatians 3:28).

In the beginning when God originally created man, He created man both male and female. The first man originally was a plural being as we see in the book of Genesis. When God made a woman, He took the "rib" or "alter ego" (literally Hebrew) out of man and made a woman. All of the characteristics in women were at one time in a man. That is why when a man and a woman come together, they become one. The characteristics of women are generally more nurturing in nature. They are motherly, sensitive, and generally more caring in nature. Our precious Lord has these

characteristics too. One of God's Hebrew name's, *"El Shaddai,"* literally means "the breasty-one." The truth is, God is both male and female. He created man originally in His image which was both male and female. He has those characteristics of a man and those of a woman. While women need to learn to exercise their God-given authority in the flow of God, men must learn to become the bride of Christ. As a general observation, men need to be tenderized while women need to be made stronger and encouraged to come forth.

Women in the body of Christ, lift up your eyes and behold the Kingdom of God that is coming. I don't care ladies where you are today and what you are doing. This word today is for you! This is the word of the Lord for this hour. I know that many women have drawn back and have sat down. But let me remind you of Isaiah 32:9, *"Rise up, ye women that are at ease, hear my voice; ye careless daughters, give ear to my speech."* The reason I believe these particular women were careless is because nobody had given them anything to run after or a vision on who they were to become in God. Far too many women don't know what their destiny is in God. If somebody told me that my destiny was to get married and cook food for the rest of my life, I don't know if that would be good enough for me. I would get slothful and lazy in Jesus if all my purpose in God was to be a good housewife. For far too long, this is what many men believed and they simply wanted to keep women in their place. God wants to

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revolutionize the body of Christ. Not only does He want the world to know He does not have the character the world thinks He has, but He is also is not a chauvinistic being in that He chooses male over female.

In Christ Jesus, there is neither male nor female. If you are living under the revelation of the fall, then you will see otherwise, thinking that men should be over everything. But in the spirit realm, in the Kingdom of God, there is neither male nor female. In the natural realm, God set men as the head of women in households and things like that. But in a spiritual sense, there is nothing in a man that is more in God's eyes than a woman. This is so important because in these last days the Scriptures reveal such a vital role women will play in God's coming Kingdom. This is seen greatly in the life of Deborah and Jael in the book of Judges. That is why the word of the Lord to women everywhere it to "rise up!"

In Judges we find Jael was the one who God used to hammer a nail in Sisera's temple to the ground and kill him. He was the captain of the host of the enemies of the children of Israel. Sisera is a type of Satan. In other words, the mind and workings of Satan are actually going to be destroyed and put to rest by a company of women in the last days. Deborah so eloquently reveals this prior to it happening. Deborah's name means "eloquent orator." She prophesies this originally to Barak, leader himself in Israel at that time.

Before I get more into the story of Deborah, I want to talk a little about Barak and Deborah's husband, Lapidoth. Lapidoth's name in Hebrew means "torches, having eyes of fire, enlightened, lightning flashes." Similarly, Barak's name means "lightning, thunder, thunderbolt." Lightning in Scriptures represents flashes of revelation. Having lightning, torches, and eyes of fire represents your vision is burning with revelation. In other words, it is going to take men who have revelation to release women. It is going to take men with revelation that see God's plan and purposes for women and the tremendous power women can have in God and do

something about it. Furthermore, this also speaks of men having true discernment as well. One cannot release somebody else until they see who they really are. What did God the Father say to Jesus when the Father released Jesus into His earthly ministry? It was during Jesus' baptism when a dove lighted upon him and Matthew 3:17 says, "And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." May men discern the true calling of God upon women in these last days.

I am in the middle of writing a book on the principle of father ministries and sons in the Lord. But this could easily speak of the principle of mothers in Zion or mothers of Israel. In the body of Christ, I myself was under several mothers in the Lord in my early days in Jesus. My first two pastors in my life were women. June Lewis and Dr. Eva Evans were other women who played vital roles in my growth in the Lord. God has had women in my life instructing me, mothering me, and ministering to me. It is a place that I believe is lacking in the body of Christ. There are not that many mothers in Zion. Why? Because many women have become careless, lazy, lackadaisical, and slothful only because they have not had a vision read plain to them that they can run after concerning their vital roles in God's coming Kingdom.

Men have not had eyes of fire concerning women to properly show them how to become a force for Jesus. Mark my words, whether I see it in my lifetime or not, God is going to use women in a mighty way in the last days. I know there are tremendous women ministers today, but too few in my opinion. I am talking about a move of God causing women to arise and take their place God has prepared for them. Like Jael, they are going to pound that nail and defeat Satan once and for all. That nail represents the Word of God. Ecclesiastes 12:11 says, "The words of the wise are as goads, and as nails fastened by the masters of assemblies, which are given from one shepherd."

In Judges 4:8 Barak tells Deborah, "If

*thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go.*" In other words, Barak had a revelation he needed Deborah to be with him. And her response is very interesting in verse 9, "I will surely go with thee; notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the Lord shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman." God has given men honor for a very long time, for thousands of years. It is time for women to get some honor! Moreover, it will be through a hand of a woman that the Lord will slay Sisera. Sisera again is a type of satan. Sisera's name means "binding with chains." He was the captain in Jabin's army. Sisera was the one that led all the intrusions into the territories of the people of God. This was during the time of the judges. When a judge over Israel would die, the children of Israel would backslide and do evil in the sight of the Lord. And before Deborah comes on the scene, we see the same script in Judges 4:1.

Speaking of the last days, Paul says in II Timothy 3:1, "This know also that in the last days perilous times shall come." Why? Because the body of Christ is going to lose its standard in the world. As I was driving to church this morning, I saw a yoga place filled to overflowing. There were more cars there than most of the churches we passed. Now I am not coming against anything, but what I am saying is somebody somewhere in the body of Christ is not doing their job. Perhaps somebody somewhere has become careless and that goes for men and women. But God wants to raise up a mighty revival in women to stir the men up. And in that move, God will give men flashes of light and revelation so they see properly women's place in ministry and in God's Kingdom. Perhaps the reason Jesus isn't moving like we want Him to is because by holding back women, we have held back 50% of the body of Christ from doing their job. I think we can all agree that as the body of Christ as a whole, we have not gotten the job done.

The Kingdom of God is not going to

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come until women rise up! After Jael defeats Sisera, we see the song of Deborah in Judges 5. In Judges 5:7 she sings, *"The inhabitants of the villages ceased, they ceased in Israel, until that I Deborah arise, that I arose a mother in Israel."* The Hebrew word for "ceased" here literally means "to be flabby or lazy." In other words, when the move of God is ceased in the land, it is because people have become flabby and lazy. But notice the "until" in this verse. The children of Israel remained mightily oppressed for twenty years (Judges 4:2-3), in bondage to Sisera until Deborah *"arose a mother in Israel."* Deborah arose a leader in Israel! This is the word of the Lord to you women! God is looking to you to arise and be the leaders He has called you to be! Perhaps the body of Christ has become flabby or lazy because there is nobody living the example before them. You be that example and help bring the next move of God!

Psalms 68:11 in the KJV says, *"The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it."* The KJV translators mistranslated this passage. The actual Hebrews reads, *"The Lord gave the word: great was the company of women that proclaimed it."* In the last days there will be a great company of women who will be publishing and proclaiming the Word of God! In Micah 4:13 it says, *"Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion..."* This means that women need to arise, get to work, and thresh. The word "thresh" means to "tread out." In other words, they are treading out the grapes, bringing the Holy Ghost, bringing the word of the Lord, walking as examples before the people of God.

As we continue to look at the importance of women arising in the last days, I want to look back in Isaiah 32. In Isaiah 32, God is speaking of His coming Kingdom. In verse 2 He says, *"And a man shall be as a hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land."* This is all speaking of the remnant that God wants to bring forth in the last days. In verses 9-10, it then goes on to say,

*"Rise up, ye women that are at ease, hear my voice; ye careless daughters, give ear unto my speech. Many days and years shall ye be troubled, ye careless women: for the vintage shall fail, the gathering shall not come."* In other words, the harvest is not going to come to fruition without women having a vital part in what is happening in the body of Christ. The remnant will have this revelation. They will be filled with men like Barak and Lapidoth who see beyond the natural flesh and see in the spirit. Isaiah 32 continues talking about the condition of the body of Christ because of women not being in their place:

*"<sup>11</sup>Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip ye, and make ye bare, and gird your sackcloth upon your loins. <sup>12</sup>They shall lament for the teats, for the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vine. <sup>13</sup>Upon the land of my people shall come up thorns and briers; yea, upon all the houses of joy in the joyous city: <sup>14</sup>Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens for ever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks..."* (Isaiah 32:11-14).

Here are a few quick points about these verses. *"They shall lament for the teats"* speaks of no teaching going on. Isaiah 28:9 relates being taught doctrine to being weaned from the breasts. In other words, the people of God are lamenting due to a lack of nourishment and teaching. Milk is for babes. They are lamenting because women are not taking their place in giving out the Word of God and as such there is no fruitful vine or pleasant fields.

Thorns speak of cares and the lusts of other things entering in choking the Word of God. There will be no joy, the house of God forsaken, and wild asses roaming the land. In other words, it will become a place for wild beasts or demons in the body of Christ until women arise and are released to do what God has called them to do.

After all this, Isaiah 32:15 finally says, *"Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful*

*field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest..."* This speaks of the last great move of God that is going to fall. It will fall when women finally arise and take their place. Until then, we will have trouble, failure, no gathering, no harvest, etc. God is waiting for women to arise so He can finally pour out His spirit upon all of us! God will not move without His entire body being part of it. He will not move until women are liberated. If women don't arise, I believe He will move it to another generation until there are men with eyes like torches with revelation about the ministry of women.

Next, let's look at the story of Deborah more closely in Judges 4:

*"<sup>1</sup>And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD, when Ehud was dead. <sup>2</sup>And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host was Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles. <sup>3</sup>And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel. <sup>4</sup>And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time. <sup>5</sup>And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Beth-el in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment."* (Judges 4:1-5)

In verse 3, we see that the children of Israel were mightily oppressed for twenty years before Deborah comes on the scene. Twenty in the Bible is the number for expectancy. Everybody was sitting around expecting something to happen but nothing happens and nobody does anything. This reminds me of that famous quote used throughout history, "the only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is that good men do nothing." The same thing can be said about women, "the only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is that good women do nothing." Deborah must have been sitting there waiting for some man to come forth and deal with the condition of God's people, but never did. So she arose a prophetess and judged Israel

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at that time. In verse 5, we even see a palm tree was named after her. This has great revelation because a palm tree in Scripture is a symbol of victory, overcoming, resurrection, strength, and worship. In other words, there was no difference between her and the victory that people sought after. As a matter of fact, when people thought of Deborah, they thought of victory, resurrection, strength, and worship.

Moreover, she dwelt under the palm tree that was between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim where the children of Israel came up to her for judgment. Judgment simply means a verdict given (good or bad). She gave verdicts. She had authority. Don't tell me women can't be pastors and give verdicts because that is what pastors do all the time. They lead people in judgment and victory. Notice as well that she dwelt between Ramah and Bethel. Bethel means "house of God." Ramah means "a lofty place, especially a place consecrated to idols." In other words, Deborah judged Israel right in the middle of their idolatry. While the children of Israel were off choosing new gods, she was right in the middle faithfully doing her job leading people out of it.

Sisters reading this, please hear me today. It doesn't matter if your husband or family is faithful. It doesn't matter if your pastor has torches in his eyes on who you are supposed to be. You just remain faithful! You just keep going on with God. You just keep believing God and God will promote you! People will recognize the authority and substance of God you will gain by remaining faithful in perhaps a place with a lot of idolatry. I cannot say this enough! It is time for women to wake up! The Hebrew word for "awake" in Judges 5:12 means to open your eyes. Open your eyes and see that the vintage is failing, the harvest hasn't come, and it doesn't matter if anybody around you responds to that. You respond and arise! Shake yourself from the dust of the flesh and fulfill the will of God for your life! Jesus will not come back to a chauvinistic body of

Christ. He is going to come back to His people who glorify His name! It is time for the sisters to open their eyes, look around, and see what really is going on. Are the men rushing to the fore-front standing for God's Kingdom? We are in a season of great transition and testing. God is about to move again. He has moved before, but I believe He won't move again until things are set in order. I believe one of those things that must be done is that women need to be loosed into their ministry. They are going to be the ones that will drive that nail through Sisera's temple. They are going to destroy the works of the devil in the earth!

Sure, Barak chased Sisera and won the battle but while he was chasing Sisera, Sisera turned into Jael's house. Look at what Jael did when confronted with Sisera. It says in Judges 4:18 that first, "*she covered him with a mantle.*" A mantle represents the anointing of God, the calling of God, the substance of God in someone's life, the double portion like Elisha, etc. There are not too many people in the Bible that carried the mantle and Jael was one of them! So let me state emphatically, that women can have mantles just like men. But she covered him with her mantle, gave him some milk, and then she drove that nail into his temples fastening it to the ground (Judges 4:19-20). She received the honor for this, not Barak. It is time for the sisters to wake up!

And this all begins with Deborah remaining faithful under a palm tree judging Israel bridging the gap between people in idolatry and the house of God. Everybody knew that if you went to Deborah, you were going to come out with some victory in your life. Something in your life will be resurrected if you went to Deborah. That was her testimony. She basically stood there just like Elijah did in his days. It was Elijah that stood in this same place declaring to the children of Israel, "*How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him,*" (1 Kings 18:21). Deborah had the ministry of Elijah declaring that the people of God were serving idols!

Judges 4 continues with the story of Deborah, "*And she sent and called Barak the son of Abinoam out of Kedesh-baphtali, and said unto him, Hath not the Lord God of Israel commanded, say-ign, Go and draw toward mouth Tabor, and take with thee then thousand men of the children of Naphtali and of Zebulun?*" (Judges 4:6). I like this. Here we see Deborah giving instruction to men. This should not be a surprise to see a woman operating like this, but sadly perhaps it is still today. The women's liberation movement should always be about women achieving equal rights in everything. Nothing should stop them from fulfilling their God-giving purpose and calling. First the natural, then the spiritual. In the spiritual realm, that same thing is taking place today. It is time for the virtuous women to arise.

Let me also say, we don't need a bunch of women like Ahab's wife ruling. We don't need women who are ruling in darkness with evil intents that aren't for the Kingdom of God and only in it for their own agenda. God is not looking for women with controlling spirits pushing forward just for the sake of pushing forward. I think we can agree the evil that has been perpetrated by men with personal ambitions leading the way. Nevertheless, women liberation has come a long way in the natural, but in the spirit, women need to come forth. Even Kathryn Kuhlman, who was one of the greatest women of God that ever lived over the past hundred years, said that the only reason she came forth was because a man never did and that is simply not true. I listened to thousands of that woman's audio messages. I watched hundreds of her meetings on videos. I used to watch her TV show, even before I got saved. Every Sunday night she was on TV when I grew up and God's hand was upon her life. The anointing she carried was like nothing I have ever seen. I felt God's presence coming out of that TV even before I got saved. God is going to raise up women just like that. He is going to raise up more women than ever with God's authority carrying a tremendous anointing. Moreover,

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they are going to be eloquent orators, just like Deborah.

In addition to “an eloquent orator,” Deborah’s name means “a bee.” I like that. Some men may be trying to swat them away to get rid of them, but won’t be able to. Their presence will be felt until men that have held women back for far too long get out of the way. God’s glory coming out of these women is going to roll over anybody in the way. They will produce honey, carrying a worked out living Word wherever they go.

In response to Deborah’s orders, Barak says he will not go anywhere without her because he knew in his heart that this woman was a mighty woman of God. Deborah had no problem telling Barak what to do and Barak had no problem receiving instruction from her. What a glorious example for these last days!

I would encourage you to read Judges 4 and Judges 5. There is so much more to say. These chapters are full of revelation. But I want to point out what happens after the Battle is won and Sisera is defeated by Jael. Judges 4:24 says, “*And the hand of the children of Israel prospered, and prevailed against Jabin the king of Canaan, until they had destroyed Jabin king of Canaan.*” Prosperity and victory came to the people of God because of Deborah and Jael!

Then in Judges 5:1, it says, “*Then sang Deborah and Barak...*” and Judges 5 is that song. To everything there is a season and a time. There is a time to sing and a time not to sing. I believe today is a time to be going after the Sisera’s in this world. Women need to arise. Men need to arise as well with this revelation. As a body of Christ, we need to arise and go after the demonic giants in our land and smiting them with the nails of the Word of God that we carry. Somebody, somewhere, needs to arise and lead the way. But once God moves again, boy what a release of worship that will ensue! Men and women worshipping together on the same level!

This is where we are headed!

This is evident today by how many tremendous women worship leaders that have come forth more than ever. While certain men have been rejecting the moving of the Holy Spirit, it is paving the way for women to come forth that are Kingdom minded. I say to all the women reading this, shake yourself! Awake and open your eyes. Don’t allow men around you to keep you in a limited role in God. You have an awesome place prepared by God! Step into that place. God will show you your vital calling in the body of Christ. This includes women in every facet of the five-fold ministry.

Lastly, consider the line of the song in Judge 5:9, “*My heart is toward the governors of Israel, that offered themselves willingly among the people. Bless ye the Lord.*” In other words, bless the elders of Israel that loosed Deborah to do her job. She was in submission to them. She was under their authority and yet led. She spoke highly of them. This should be the testimony of the body of Christ.

I have never had a problem receiving from women. Anybody that has a soft tender heart to the Lord will always respond to the anointing and authority of God. Women that carry the true anointing and authority of God will have a voice and platform like never before. People will respond. God will make it evident by their lives. It is time for the women to arise! I whole-heartedly believe this is the word of the Lord for this hour. I am trying my hardest here to write the vision and make it plain for everybody to run after it, men and women, together, so God’s remnant can come forth and the last great move of God can come. But it won’t happen without the women arise, taking their place, and are allowed to be loosed holding forth the word of life carrying God’s Kingdom with them!

When we think of the overcomers in the Bible, we need to stop thinking of just the men. There are so many passages that speak of the “*daughters of Zion*” and quite frankly do not even mention

men. Women, may your eyes be opened today with the high, heavenly, and holy calling written for you! It has always been there! Zephaniah 3:14 proclaims, “*Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; Be glad and rejoice with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem.*” The Lord is addressing the remnant there! Zechariah 2:10 says, “*Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion: For, lo, I come, and I will dwell in the midst of thee, saith the Lord.*” This is God’s promise in the last days about the Lord dwelling in the midst of the daughters of Zion. It doesn’t mention anything about men there.

Lastly in Isaiah 4 when the Lord is glorified in the last days it is predicated upon, “*When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion... by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning...*” (Isaiah 4:2-6). God is going to purge the body of Christ and I believe the daughters of Zion are at the very forefront of that purging, just like Deborah sitting there in the midst under that palm tree. That palm tree was dedicated to her name. In the middle of idolatry Deborah was doling out the Word of God bringing judgment back to the body of Christ. She brought the Word of the Lord to men and women and was associated with victory, strength, resurrection, and worship! All hell was breaking loose in Israel “*until that I Deborah arose, that I arose a mother in Israel,*” (Judges 5:7). One translation of this reads “*I arose a mother protector in Israel.*” Another translation reads, “*a mother leader.*” It is time to awake sisters. It is time to arise women of Zion. It is time to open your eyes and see the word of the Lord. The Kingdom of God is suffering because you sisters are not ministering but it won’t be suffering for much longer, in Jesus’ name! Amen!
