

A Remnant Walking

This lesson will bring great hope to all of us. Hope of what we shall become. Hope of what we will break through in to. This is the picture of God's holy remnant, a people made up of lame, afflicted outcasts. I don't know about you, but that gives me hope. That means I can make it in. Hallelujah! These dear saints, humble people just like you and me, are made by God into a mighty remnant, who inherit again all that men originally had. This walk they enter into is paradise restored. My heart yearns for this; the Father's heart yearns for this. To have a people who enter into all that he has provided for them from the foundation. As this scripture is opened to us by the spirit of revelation we will see a remnant walking.

- I. Micah 4:5-8 – *"⁵For all people will walk every one in the name of his god, and we will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever. ⁶In that day, saith the LORD, will I assemble her that halteth, and I will gather her that is driven out, and her that I have afflicted; ⁷And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever. ⁸And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem."*

A. Verse 5

1. "Walk" in Hebrew; to carry away, to bear, to bring, to flow
2. *"For all people will walk everyone in the name of his god..."* – This reveals that in the last days everyone will have chosen to serve somebody. All will belong to some god.
 - a. Gods (Allah, Buddha, Mohamed, etc) – Idol, could represent anything but something they serve – In the last days everyone will be walking in the name (nature) of the thing they serve. Be it some religious entity or some worldly thing they lust after. Some will have chosen certain religions and deities and will serve them with total affection and devotion. Others will be completely given over to the nature of the idol that controls them (lust, hate, greed, power, etc)
3. *"...and we will walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever."* – Praise the Lord, "we" this is speaking of the saints who make up this remnant, born again, spirit filled children of God. Everyone else will be doing their thing, serving their gods, walking in the nature of the idols that they serve, but Hallelujah!, the Sons of God will be too! We will walk in the nature of Jesus forever and ever. We will be consumed, totally given over to and walking in the name (nature, and authority of our God). These will do the greater works of Jesus, walking in His authority.
 - a. "Walk" in Hebrew, *yalak* – to carry, to bear, to bring, to flow; We will carry, bear, bring and flow in His nature and authority, bringing deliverance and healing and the message of Jesus to the world. These will manifest the Son of God. And they will do this forever and ever. Throughout eternity this will be their right. They have been changed into that heavenly image.
 - b. We will carry, bear, bring and flow in His divine nature. This is the manifestation of the Sons of God

B. Verse 6

1. *"In that day, saith the Lord..."* – That day, is the day of the Lord. In verse one we see the context is the "last days". This is a day that is coming, a day that is about to dawn. Right before the coming of the Lord is the beginning of the day of the Lord. That day lasts throughout the millennium.

2. *"I will assemble..."* – God will be doing this, **not men**. The Hebrew word for assemble means call to together
3. *"...her that halteth..."* – He is calling her that is lame.
 - a. What is a lame man?
 - 1) Hebrew; to hop, to hesitate, to skip over
 - 2) One whose walk is impaired
 - 3) One who is out of balance – Proverbs 26:7
 - 4) One who is always carried and one who begs
 - b. The lame were not allowed to offer sacrifice or come before God
 - 1) Leviticus 21:18 – *"For whatsoever man he be that hath a blemish, he shall not approach: a blind man, or a lame, or he that hath a flat nose, or any thing superfluous,"*
 - 2) Deuteronomy 15:21 – *"And if there be any blemish therein, as if it be lame, or blind, or have any ill blemish, thou shalt not sacrifice it unto the LORD thy God"*
 - c. How will they enter in?
 - 1) Hebrews 12:10-13 – God's dealings
 - 2) Acts 3:7-8 – Healed by God's power
 - d. These are the ones God calls
 - 1) I Corinthians 1:26-29
 - 2) Luke 14:12-14
 - e. The day is coming when the lame will become the Sons of God
 - 1) Isaiah 33:23 – *"Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey."*
 - 2) Isaiah 35:6 – *"Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert."*
 - 3) Jeremiah 31:8-9
 - 4) II Kings 7:3-8
 - 5) Luke 14:12-24 – This passage is speaking of the bride
4. *"...and I will gather..."* – Once again this is His doing. (Ephesians 1:10). And men will not be able to resist His call to gather together in one.
5. *"...her that is driven out..."*
